A neighbor ham, Lash Larue WØRQI, called the other day to let me know that he's regrettably having to move from his antenna-covenant-free QTH here in S. Jeffco to a lower altitude for health reasons.

Lash would really prefer to sell the place to a ham to save him the expense of removing his awesome 65-foot Triax free-standing crank-up tower, complete with a 10 - 30 MHz log periodic and 2m gain omni.

Lash has built a nice sun room with thermopane glass onto the W. side, and the large lot also has a huge 400 sq. ft. wooden shed.

The address is 5682 W. Chestnut Ave., Littleton, CO 80128, located in the quiet, mature Columbine Hills subdivision of S. Jeffco, just off the C470 Platte Canyon exit. Here's a link to the place:
